

FOUND: I found a set stone substantially fitting the G.L.O. record dimensions with a few other loose stones Surrounding it. The stone is set with north-south orientation as it should be. A set post is located approximately 15 feet east of the stone. I believe this is a line marker for HyWest power line as it merged from it's 30' offset at the road intersection at the Northeast Corner of Section 9 to the Section Corner location at the Southeast Corner of Section 9. As the power line extends southerly from the quarter corner location, it intersects and follows the exact course of old fence posts marking the easterly boundary of Section 9.

SET: An aluminum survey cap, marked L.S. 9063, and marked appropriately for the Quarter Corner At the position of the found stone.
