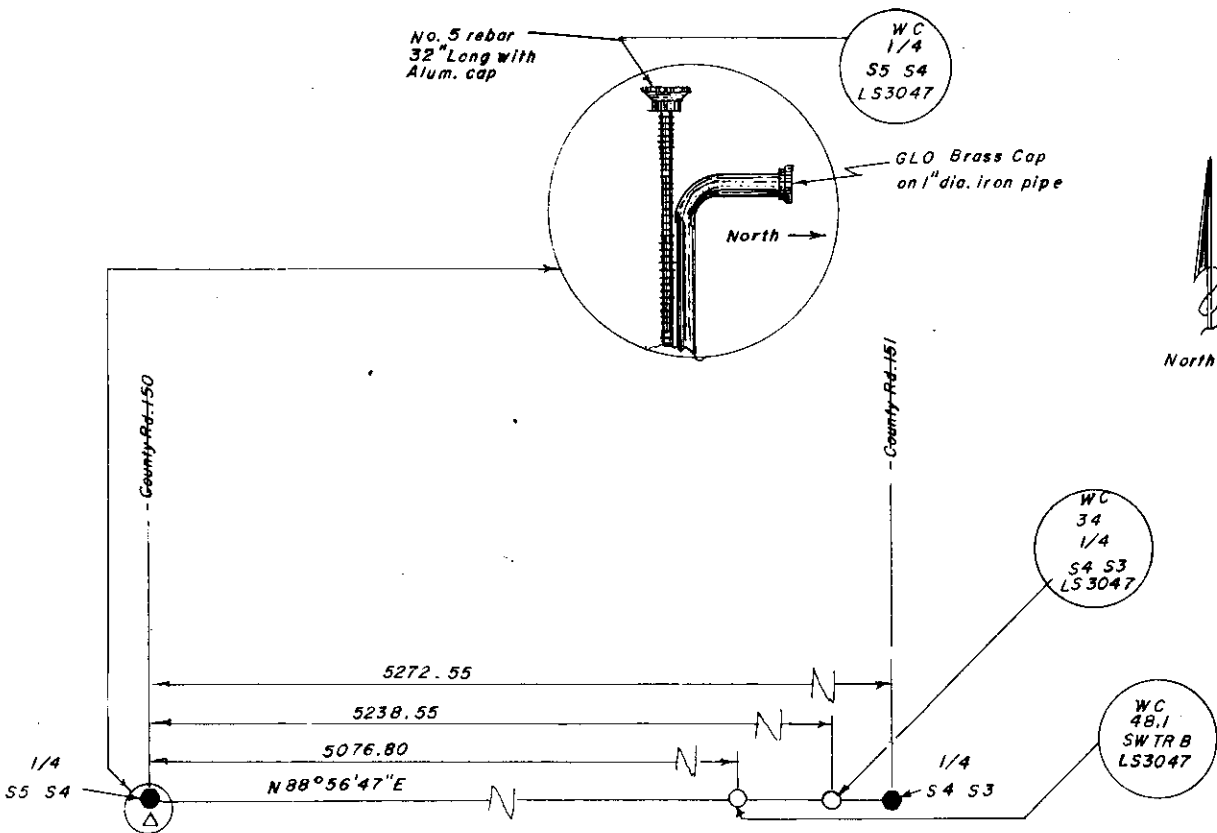
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (if known)

G.L.O. Retracement survey accepted 28 May 1913 by the Surveyor General, of T12N., R62W. 6th PM calls for 1" dia iron pipe with a brass cap.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Found monument as described 1.3 ft below the surface of County Road 150. The iron pipe was bent towards the North. Set 32" long No 5 rebar on the South side of the monument as shown. The rebar, as shown, has an aluminum cap marked as a witness corner and buried approximately 0.4 ft below road surface.
