DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)

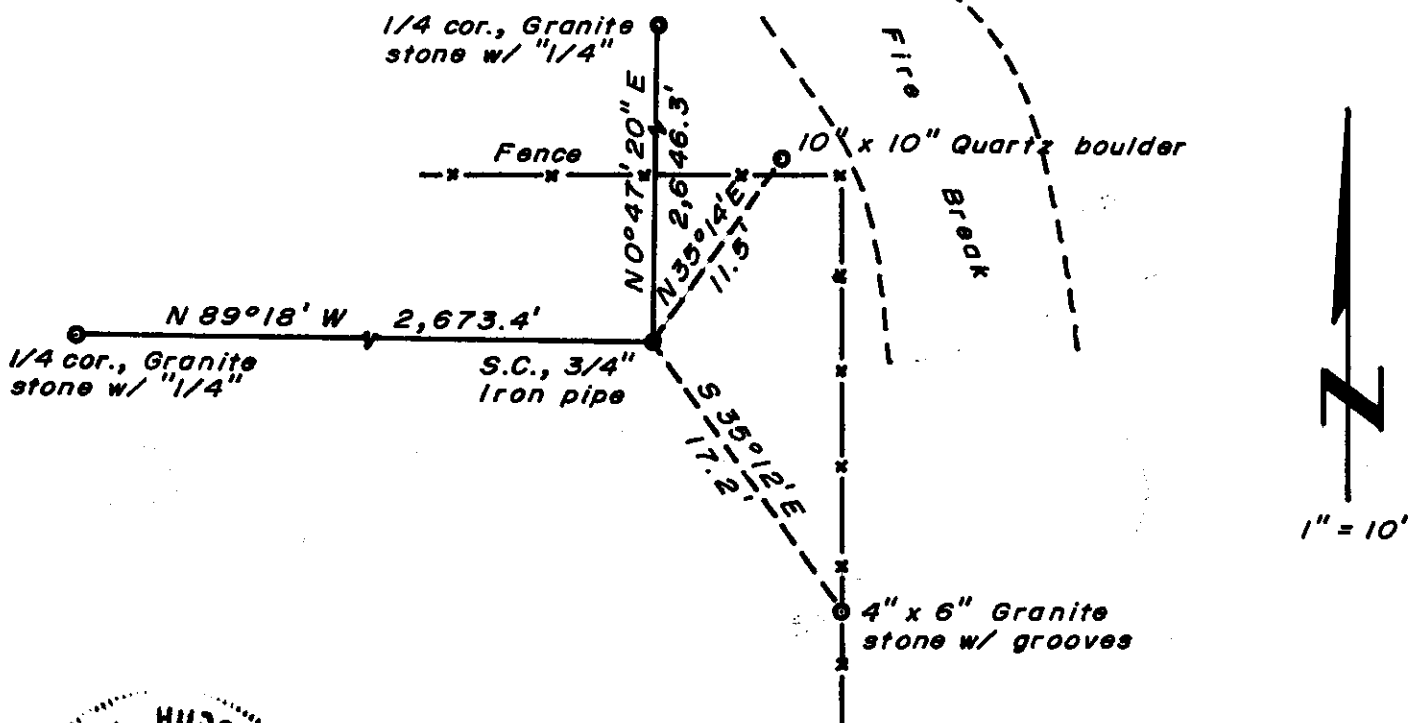

Found a 3/4" dia. iron pipe, 0.6 foot below surface. Call monument of the field notes of a survey made in March, 1946, by T. H. Baldwin.  
 G.L.O. record - Sandstone, 21" x 9" x 3".

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

A 10" x 10" Quartz boulder, unmarked, bears N 35° 14' E, 11.5 feet distant. (This stone appears to have been used by the Wyoming Highway Department for survey of U.S. Highway 85 and description recorded in Book 564 at page 498 on 11 Feb. 1955 at office of Laramie County Clerk.)  
 A 4" x 6" Granite stone, with 3 grooves on N. and E. faces, well set, bears S 35° 12' E, 17.2 feet distant. (Origin unknown.)
