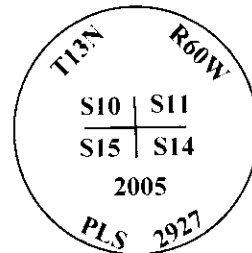
Subsequent Record: Laramie County Road Records indicate original County Road No. 52, presently titled Laramie County Road No. 164, (aka Cemetery Road) was established in December 23, 1908 and surveyed circa September, 1909 and noted in County Roads Field Notes Book #6A pages 9-12, located in the Laramie County Planning Office.

Unrecorded survey plat located in Laramie County Planning offices county road file folder titled "R 164", indicates a survey dated October 3, 1983, of a tract of land located in the SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 10, T.13N., R.60W., by Burr D. Leibert, Wyoming R.L.S. No. 171. The survey indicates a recovered No. 4 rebar for the southeast corner of Section 10.

Found: No. 5 x 24" rebar noted as a recovered No. 4 rebar in the above Leibert survey.

Set: No. 5 x 24" rebar with 3 1/4" diameter Brass Cap, marked as noted below, 3" below asphalt roadway.

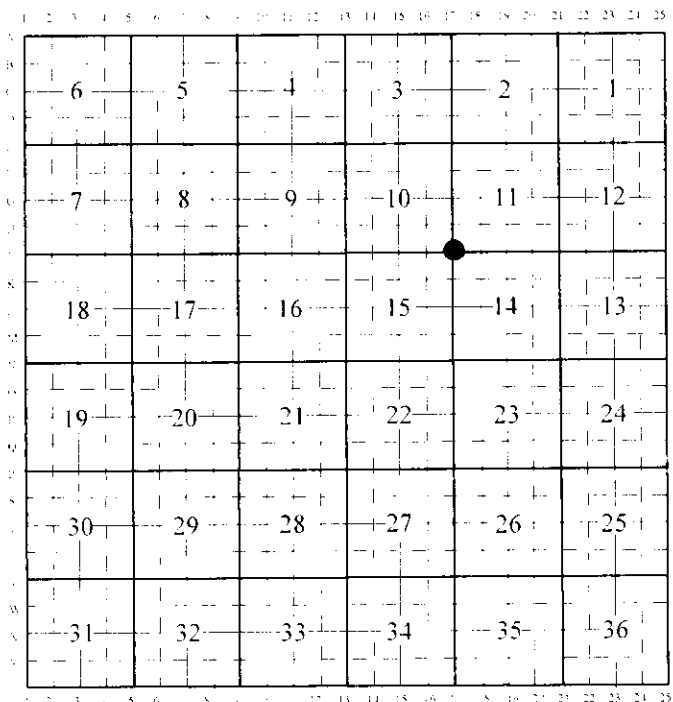
Brass Cap Markings

CROSS INDEX DIAGRAM



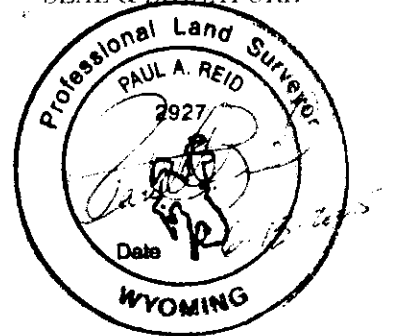
