Studley, Wyoming PLS No. 4828, indicating a found 2" diameter aluminum survey cap set flush with the asphalt paving for County Road 203, stamped in accordance with the B.L.M. Manual of Instructions and with "WYO. P.L.S. NO. 2927 - S.S.S. - 1992"

Found: A 2" diameter aluminum survey cap as indicated by Mr. John Studley. This cap was a no. 5 x 24" rebar with 2" diameter aluminum cap set by me in 1992 while employed by Steil Surveying Services. Unfortunately a corner record was not filed for the corner I had set as I was primarily employed as a field boundary surveyor and never followed up on the filing of corner records. The 2" diameter aluminum cap was set by me after a careful retracement of the Carpenter Cemetery boundary and based upon the Mr. Edward Fry corners found in the field.


Set: After verifying the monument location in relation to the Mr. Ed Fry survey and monuments of the Carpenter Cemetery, I remove the 2" diameter aluminum cap set by me in 1992 and reset with a 2 1/2" diameter aluminum cap, marked as noted below, 0.1' below the asphalt roadway.

CROSS INDEX DIAGRAM


