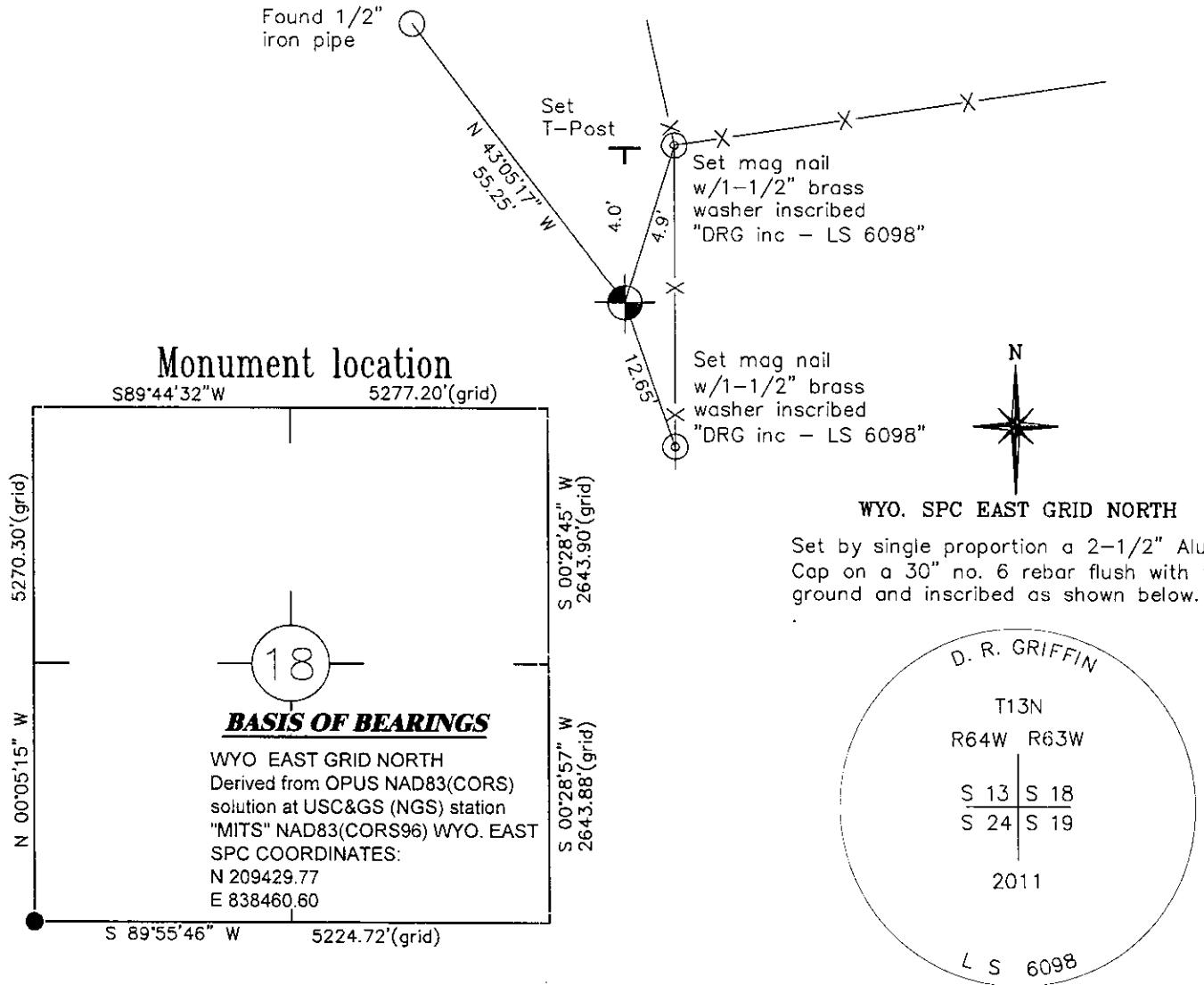

U.S.G.L.O. 1870 Record: Set a limestone 15x10x5 for corner to sections 13, 24, 18 & 19.

No Evidence of monument or accessories found. Corner is lost.

Establish corner position by single proportion from the found monument (no. 4 rebar) for the southwest corner of Section 19 and the found monument (no. 4 rebar) for the northwest corner of Section 18. Set a 2-1/2" Aluminum Cap on a 30" no. 6 rebar flush with the ground and inscribed as shown below.

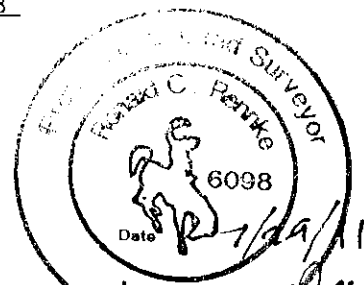
