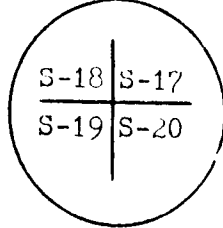


DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (if known)



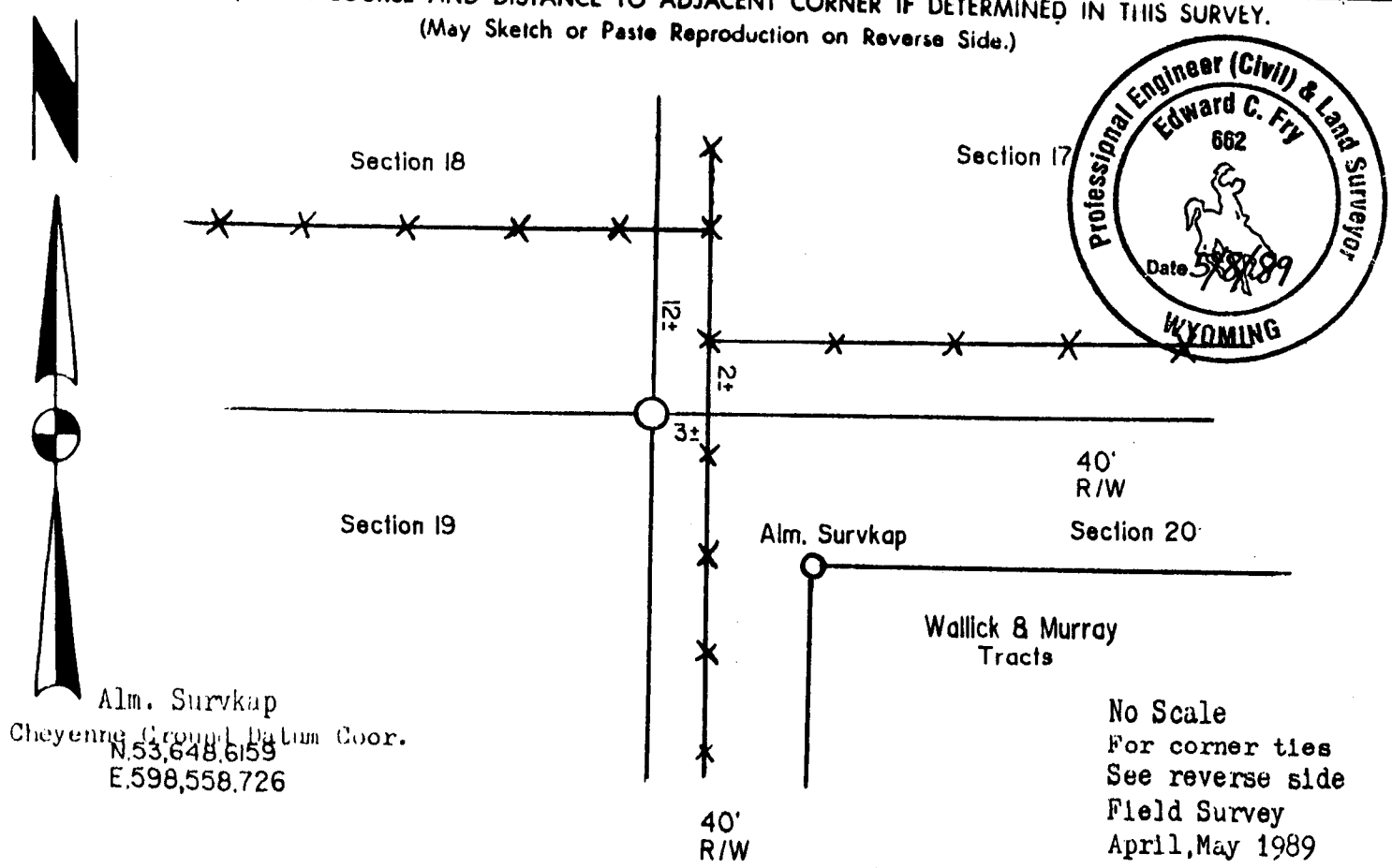
