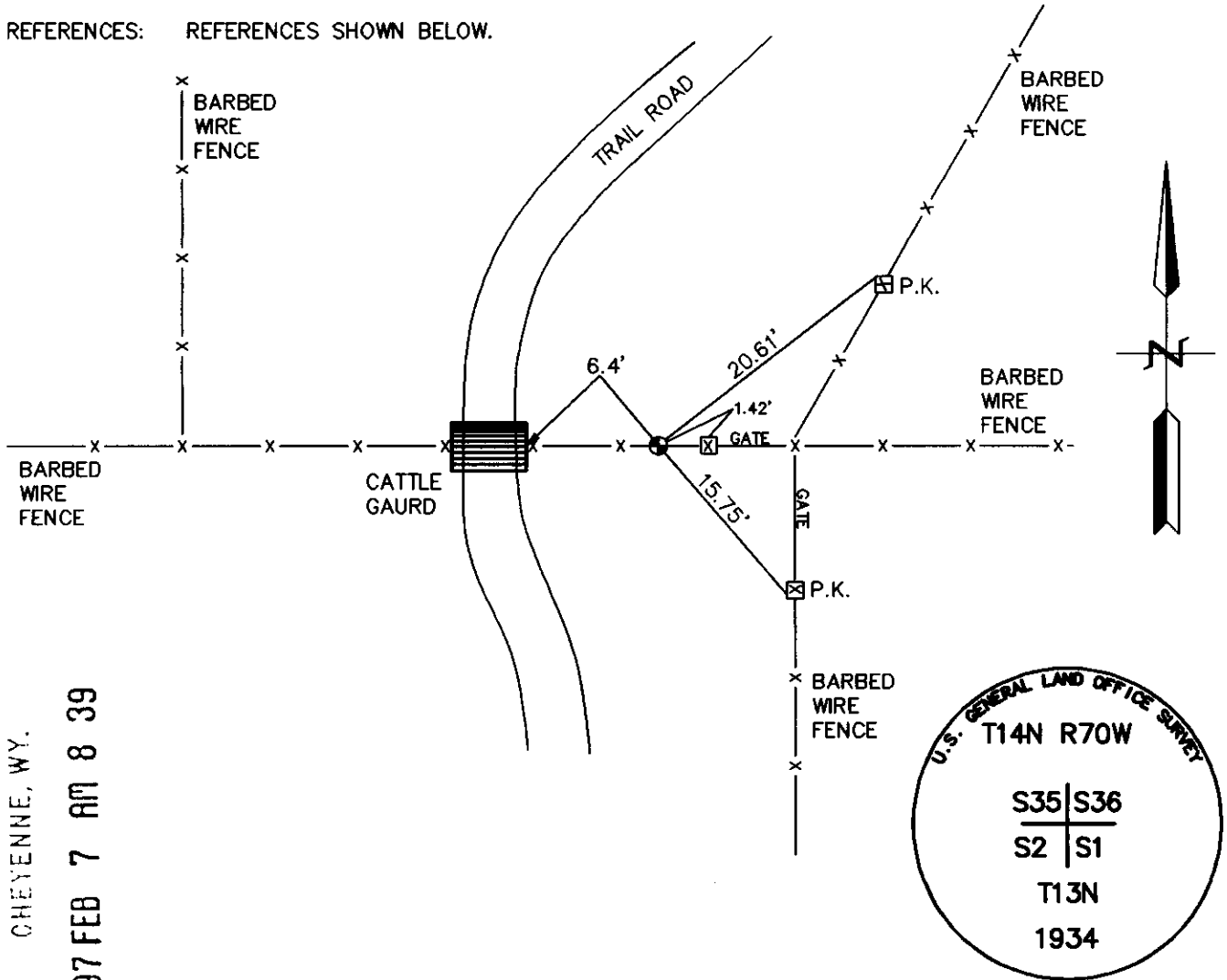

MONUMENT FOUND: FOUND A 3" GLO BRASS CAP BURIED 0.3' DEEP.

MONUMENT SET: SET NOTHING.

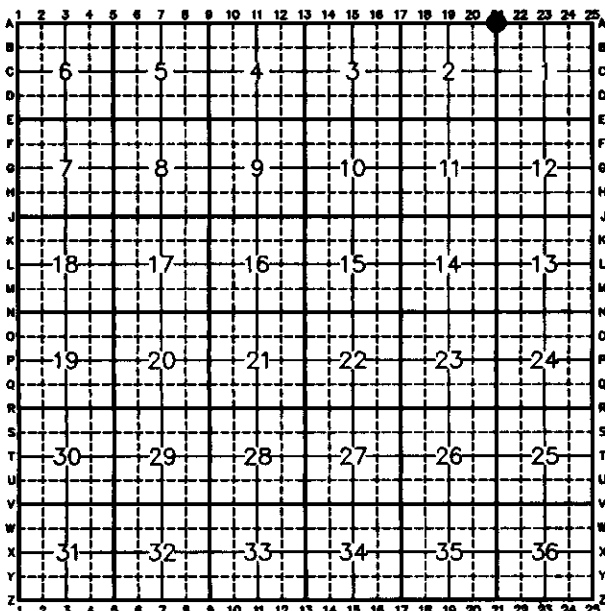
