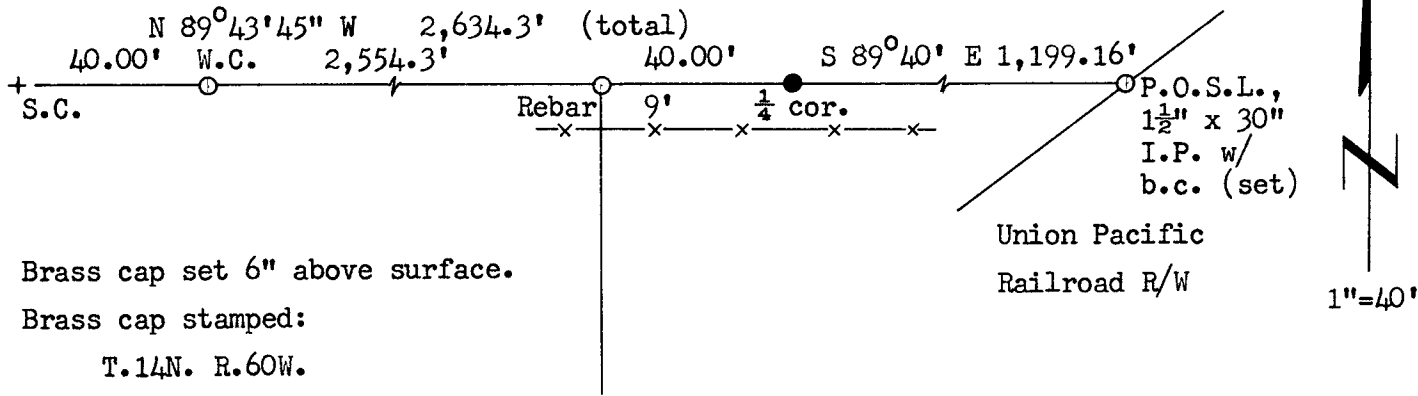

Basis of bearing by solar observation.

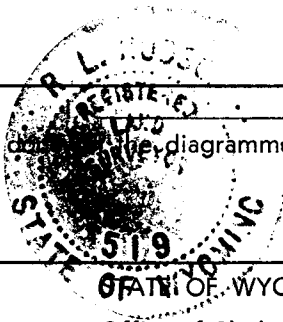
