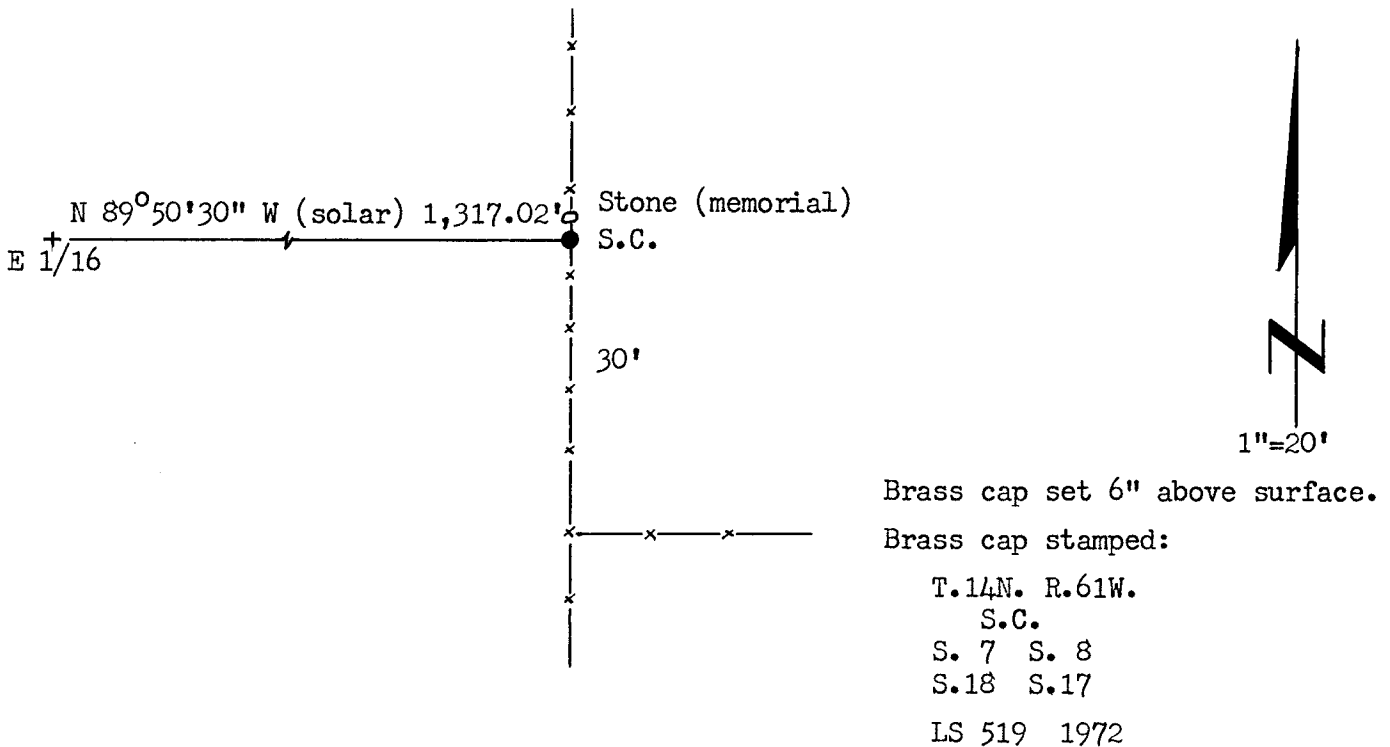

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED  
 TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Corner position accepted as point marked by old locust fence post bearing SE'ly, 4.3 feet distant from floating stone.  
 Set 1 1/2" dia. x 30" long iron pipe with brass cap for corner.  
 Left stone as memorial.
