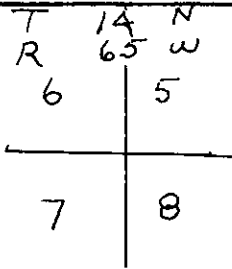


CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)

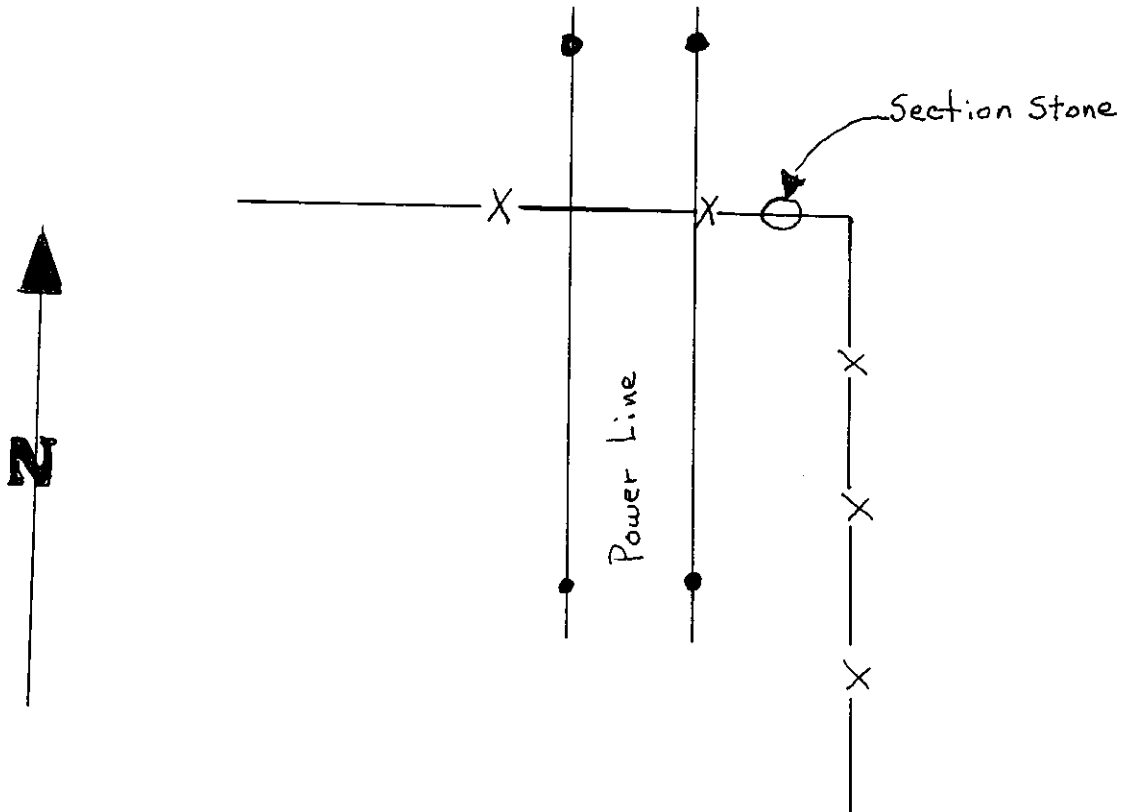
