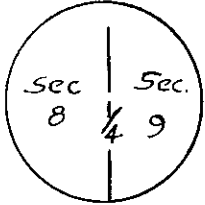


CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

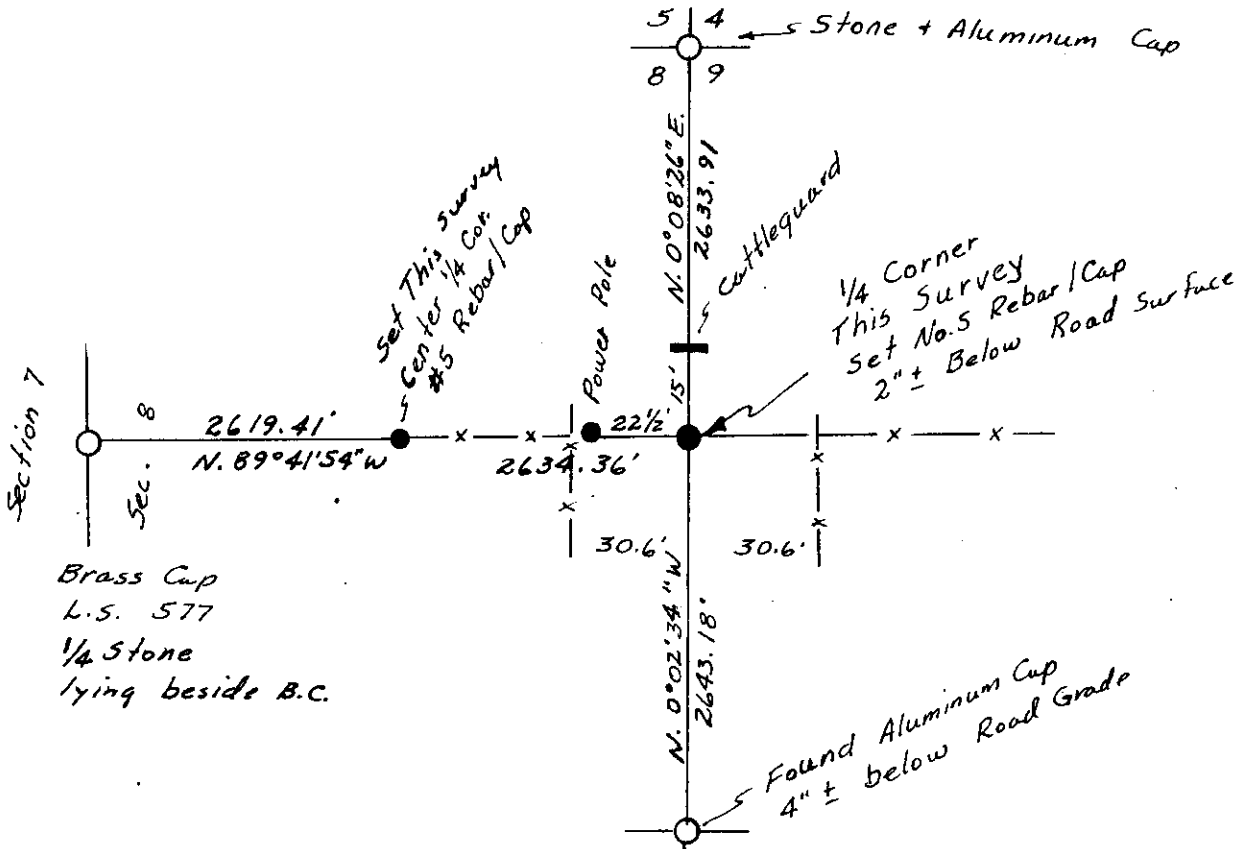

Set a #5 Rebar with aluminum cap 2" \pm below road grade.
