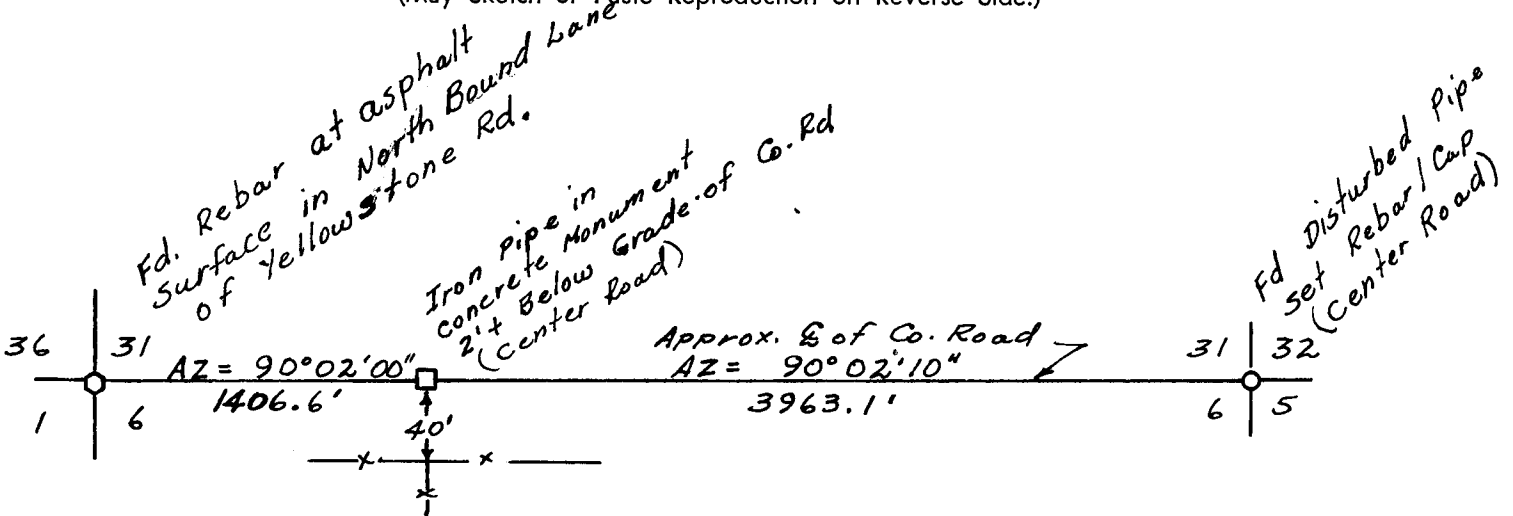

I am of the opinion that the concrete monument was set as the northeast corner of lot 4 by T. H. Baldwin in a survey made in 1936 for American Memorial Parks Inc. (Ref. Book 16 Pages 86 + 87 of Mr. Baldwin's Notes). The disturbed pipe at the northwest corner of Section 5 is believed to have been set by Malcolm Martin in a survey made in 1955 for T.A. Fennel. The bottom of the pipe appeared to be undisturbed and was used to set the rebar/cap as the accepted sec. Corner
