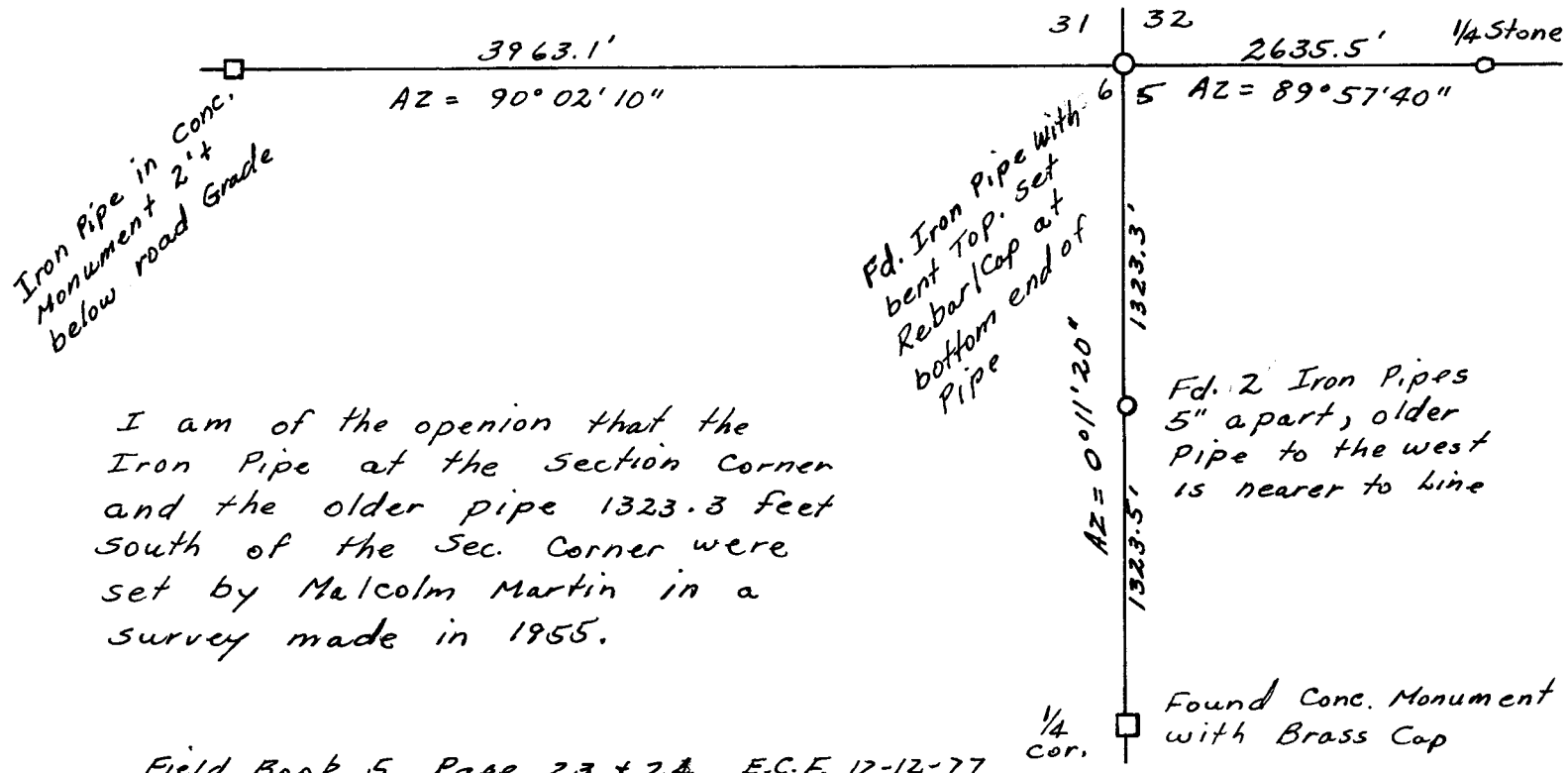
Found Iron Pipe with top bent. The location is in the middle of a County Road. The pipe probably was bent by road construction. The bottom of the pipe appeared to be undisturbed and was used as the section corner. The original corner monument was described as a 14" x 8" x 6" Granite Boulder.
