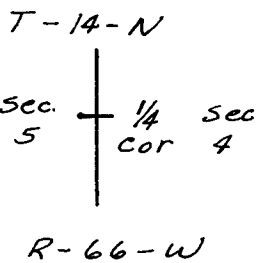

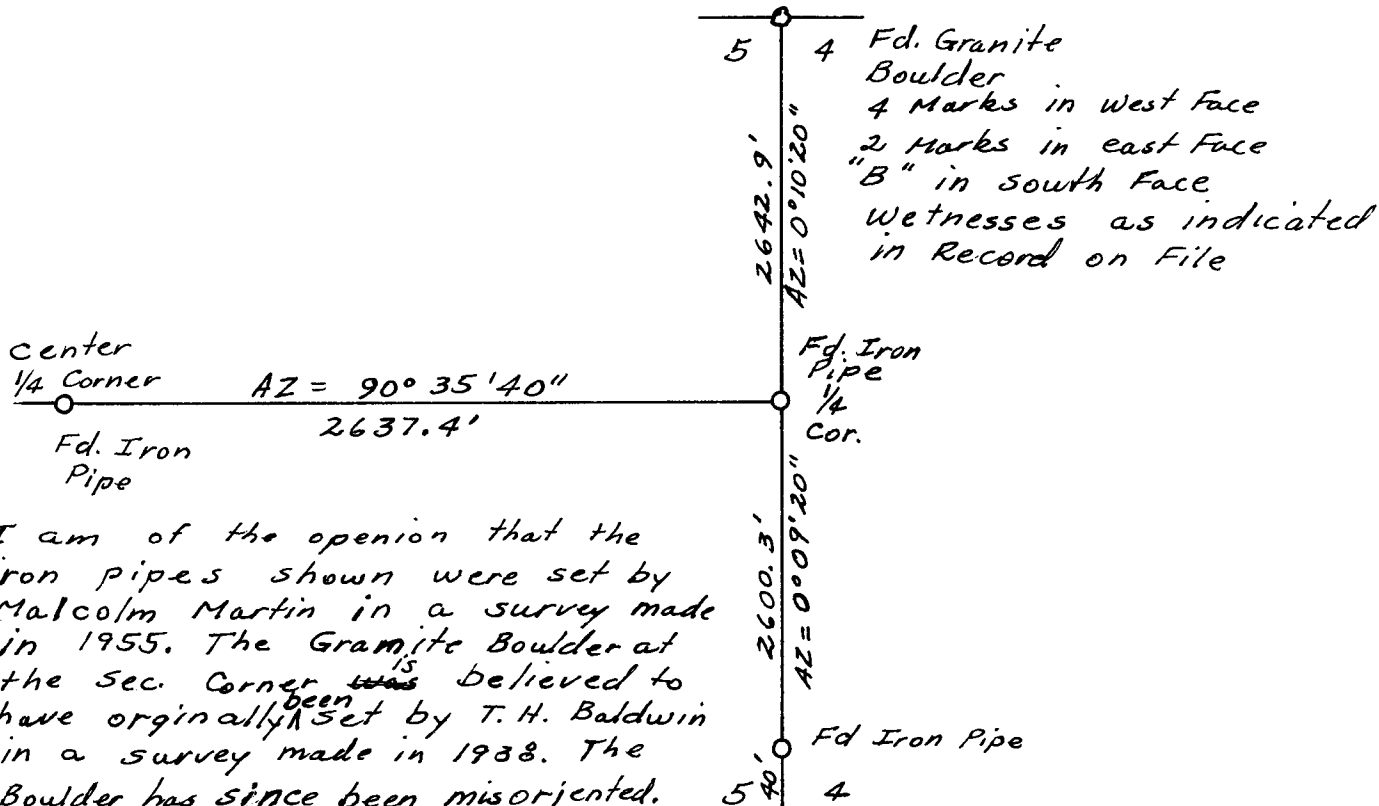
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)
