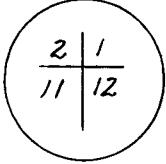


**CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION**

T-14-N, R-66-W.



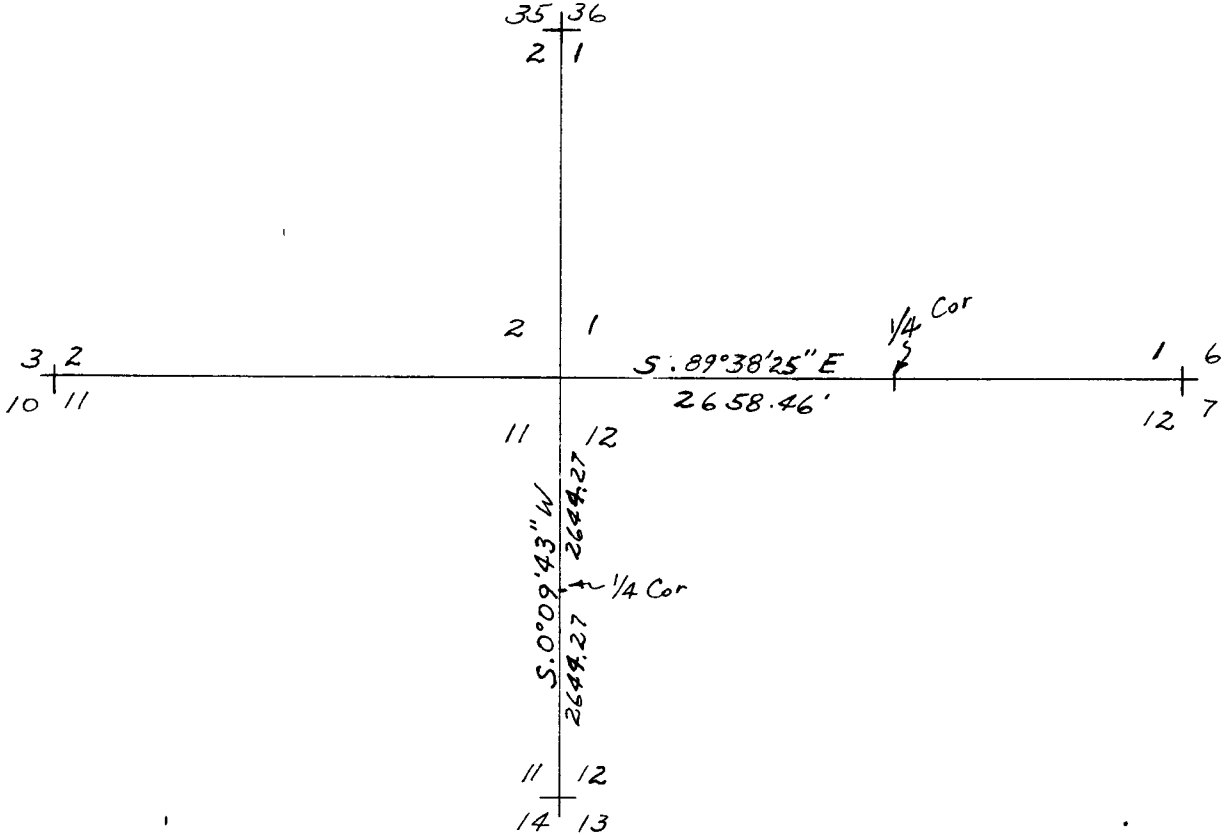
**DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)**

Original monument described as a 20" x 12" x 5" limestone. Found a 7" x 6" x 10" sandstone containing proper marking lying loose in fence line 20'± west of established property corner fences. Survey indicated that the fence corner location is compatible with other corner locations in the area, therefore was accepted as the best available evidence indicating the section corner location.

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

Set a 1 1/2" Iron Pipe with markings indicating Sec. Corner. Also set found stone as reference marker.
