

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

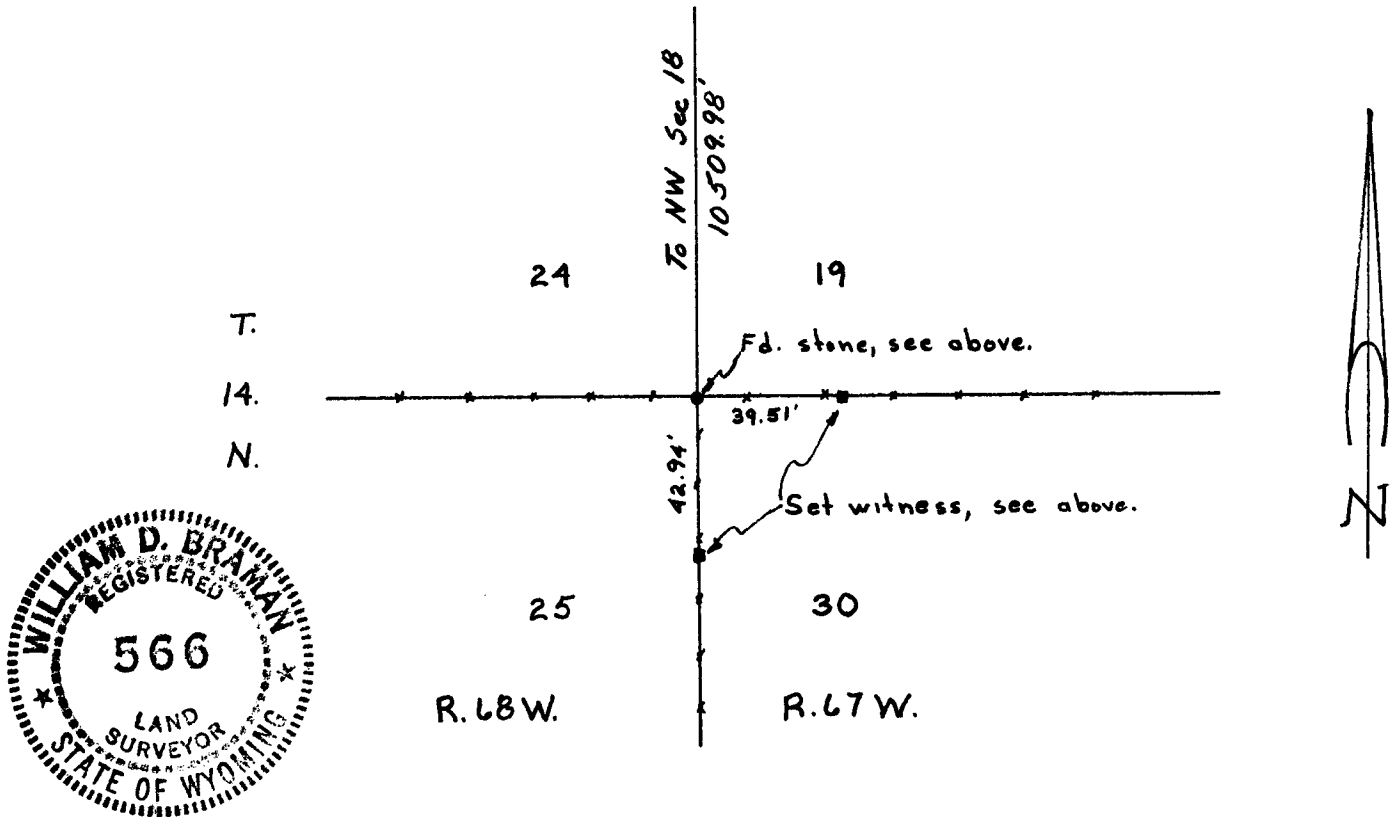
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)

Found pink granite stone set in place, 6" x 9" x 8" exposed; has 4 chisel marks on North, 2 chisel marks on South. Fence post adjacent to stone.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Chiseled "X" on top of stone.
Set 5/8" x 18" rebars, with Surv-kaps marked "Witness Corner, LS 566, 1978", as witnesses, see below for distnaces.
