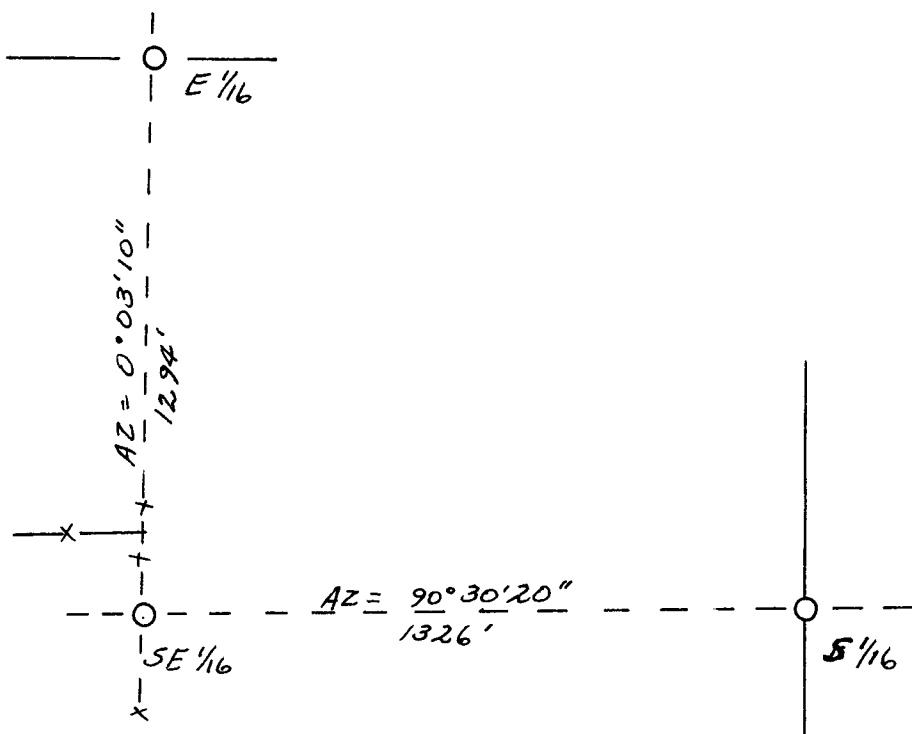
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)

Original Notes (1934 Sub. Sec. 30) calls for an X on a 5' x 3' x 3' granite boulder with W.C. set 0.02 chains south of corner. I found the W.C. but due to moss cover on boulder I could not identify X. The W.C. later disappeared. The only other people known to be present at the time the W.C. disappeared was the
