Subsequent Record: Laramie County Road Records, County Field Book No. 7, circa October 1, 1909, indicates the road was surveyed and notes "Set two CR stone E & W Cor. loose position good "Certified Land Corner Recordation filed Feb. 21, 1986, by Mr. Jeffery D. Youngquist. R.L.S. 3515 indicates this corner to be "marked by a No. 4 rebar, set 4" below the surface of a asphalt road, on centerline of N.-S. road and fenced R.O.W.'s and on centerline of fence R.O.W. to East and West.

Found: Found the above mentioned No. 4 rebar. This rebar was a No. 5 rebar, 12" in length. This found rebar was not accepted as the true corner position, due to it not being compatible with the Laramie County Road Records and accepted corner positions north and south. The found rebar was centered on a fenced lane extending easterly that is not indicated by Laramie County Road Records as a County Road Right of Way and inconsistent with the centerline of Laramie County Road No. 220 westerly. At 56.4 feet southwesterly of the intersection of Laramie County Roads No. 220 and 149, I found the remnants of a partially marked County Road Stone that I find no reference to in the Laramie County Road Records Field Books.

Set: At the intersection of Laramie County Road No. 220 and 149, that I find harmoniously related to accepted corner positions of the original survey and Laramie County Road Records, I set a No. 5 x 24" rebar with a 2 1/2" diameter aluminum cap marked as noted below, flush to the asphalt surface of Laramie County Road No. 149


