State of Wyoming Corner Record filed August 16, 2010 by Mr. Joesph W. Manatos, Wyoming PLS 573, indicating found

" a 3/4" spike set 2 1/2' below the surface of Laramie County Road 220."

On December 26, 2011, I found the above noted spike 3 ins. below the graded roadway of Laramie County Rod No. 220. The found spike of unkown origin was 2.5 ft. south of the center line of Laramie County Road No. 220. On several subsequent surveys and with measurements to other found corners in the area, I did not accept the spike. The constructed roadway appeared to be on the section line as there was a "bend" in the county road at the longitudinal intersection of a fence north and trail road center line south. It was assumed that due care had been exercised in placing the road and

improvements on the section line due to the "bend" in the road at the range line.

At the intersection of an old property bundary fence north and latitudinal center line of Laramie County Road No. 220, I set a no. 5 x 24 ins. rebar with 2 1/2 ins. diam. alum. cap, marked as noted below, 6 ins. below the graded county road.

From the monument:

The spike noted above bears south 2.5 ft.


A 16d nail set in a fence corner post bears north 34.4 ft.

A 16d nail set in a fence corner post bears southeast 47.8 ft.

The re-established northeast corner of Section 7, a 2 1/2 ins. diam. alum. cap, bears N89°27'E 5197.4 ft.

The re-established southwest corner of Section 7, a 2 1/2 ins. diam. alum. cap, bears S0°15'W 5250.6 ft.


