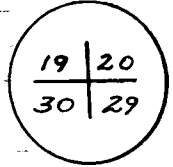

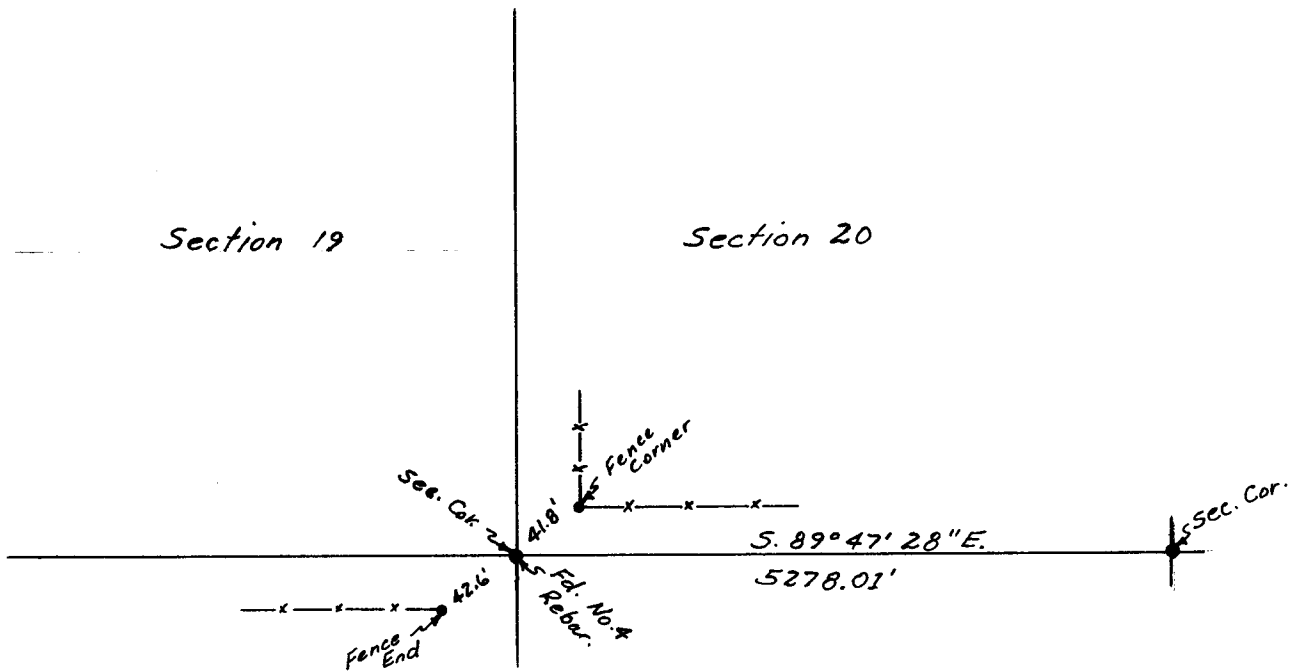


Found No.4 Rebar at location as indicated below. Origin unknown. This point was found to be compatible with the section corner to the east, therefore was accepted as the section corner.
