G.L.O. record - Granite boulder, 18 x 14 x 3. Contract survey by Henry G. Hay in 1871.

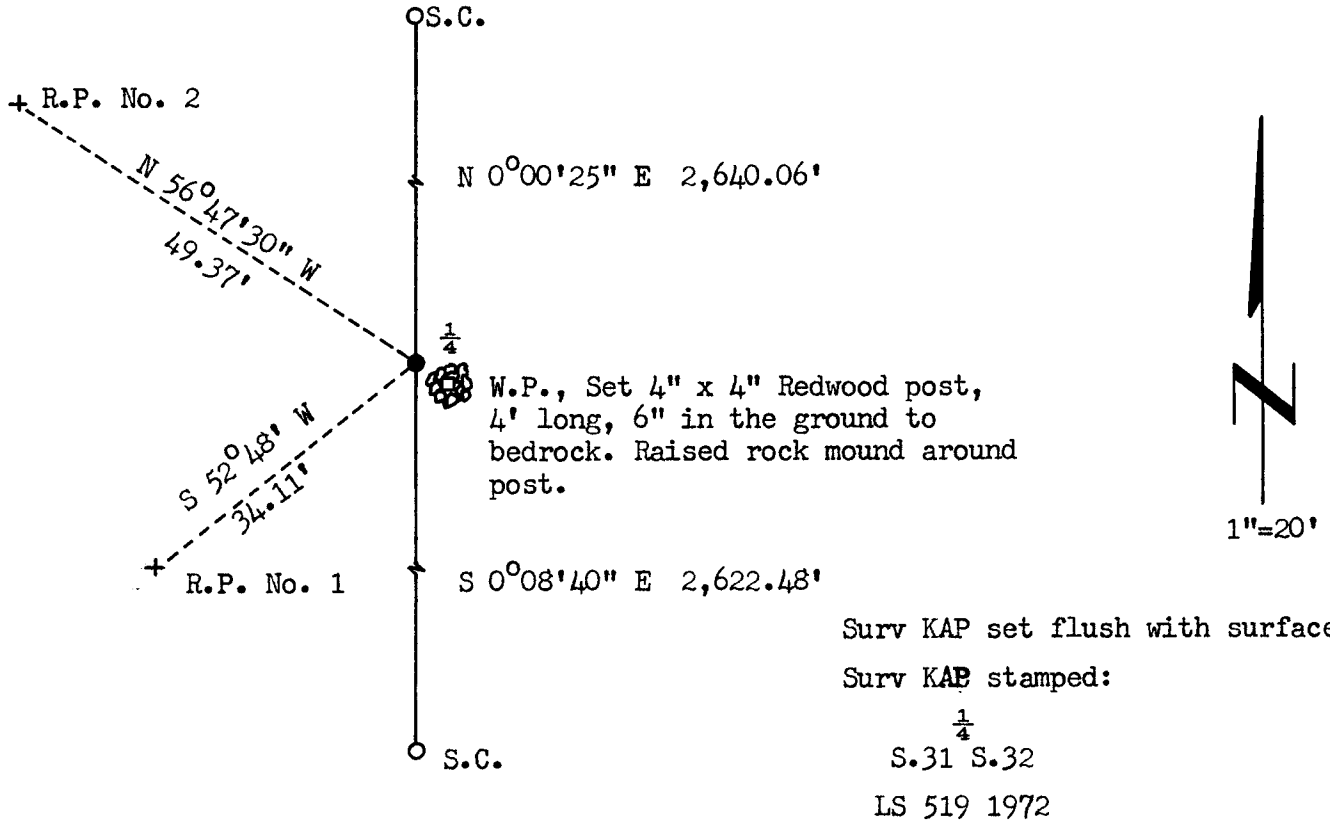
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the corner: Set a 5/8" dia. x 24" long rebar with Surv KAP in crack in granite bedrock.

Accessories: R.P. No. 1 - A chiseled "X" and "NO 1" in granite outcrop bears S 52°48' W, 34.11 feet distant.

R.P. No. 2 - A chiseled "X" and "NO 2" in granite outcrop bears N 56°47'30" W, 49.37 feet distant.
