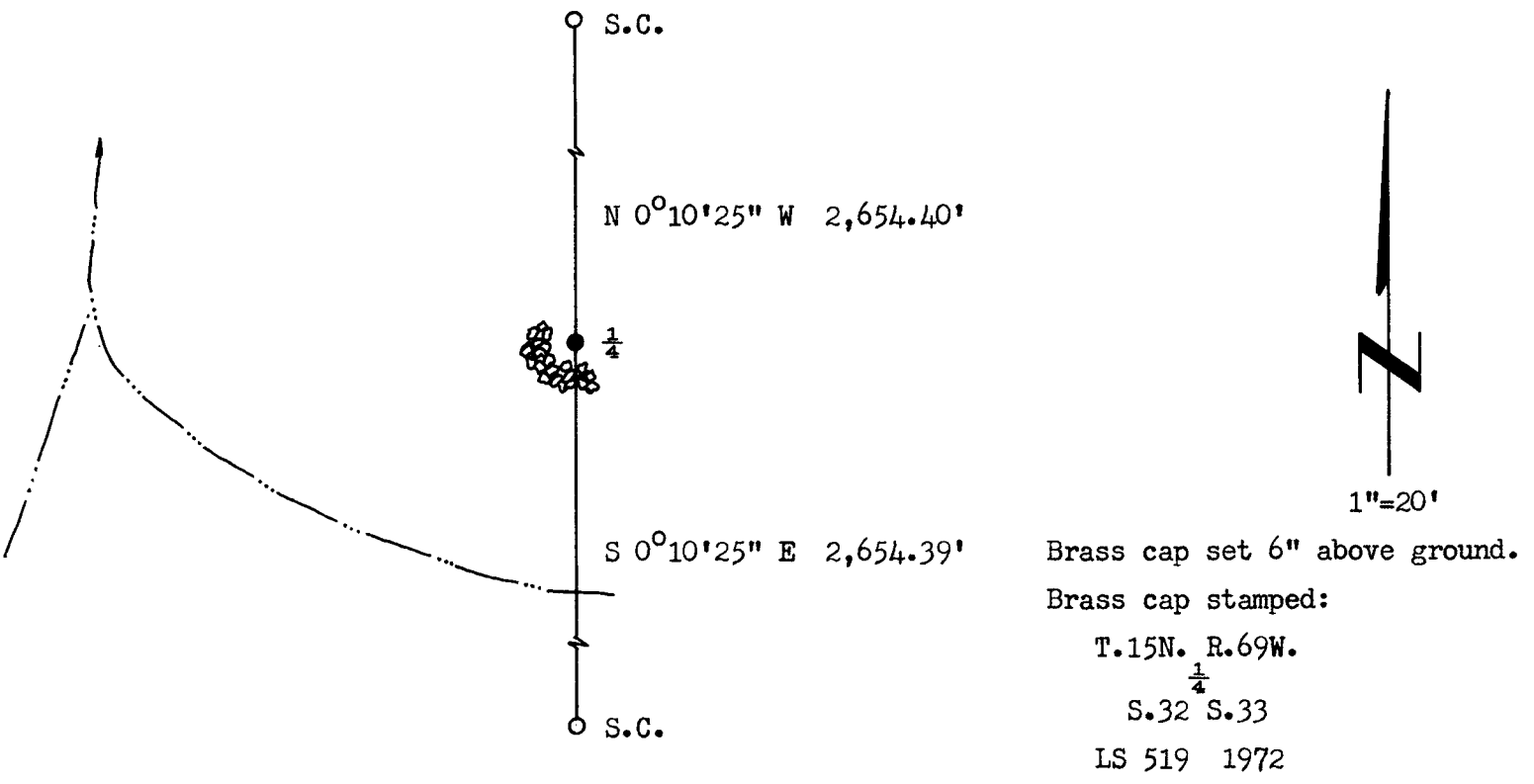

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known) Found 6" x 10" x 18" granite boulder with " $\frac{1}{4}$ ", lying on top of ground. Corner re-established by single proportionate measurement. G.L.O. record - Granite boulder, 18 x 14 x 8. Contract survey by Henry G. Hay in 1871.
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DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:	
At the corner:	Set a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. x 30" long iron pipe with brass cap.
Accessories:	Raised a rock mound, as shown in sketch. Left stone as memorial.
