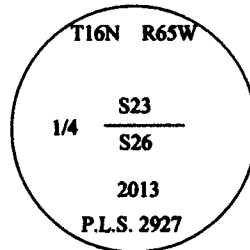

**G.L.O. Record:** John B. Thomas, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, June 1871

**Found:** No. 4 x 18 ins. rebar. This monument was utilized by me, in a survey while employed by Steil Surveying Services, for the McConnaughey #1-23 well location in 1992. On July 1, 1992, based upon long time constructed fences and landowner testimony, I re-monumented the No. 4 rebar with a No. 5 x 24 ins. rebar with a 1 1/2 ins. diam. marked aluminum cap.

**Set:** Set a No. 6 x 24 ins. rebar with 3 1/4 ins. diam. alum. cap, flush to the ground. I buried the 1 1/2 ins. diam. alum. cap and rebar alongside as a memorial. Raised a small mound of stone east.

### Aluminum Cap Markings

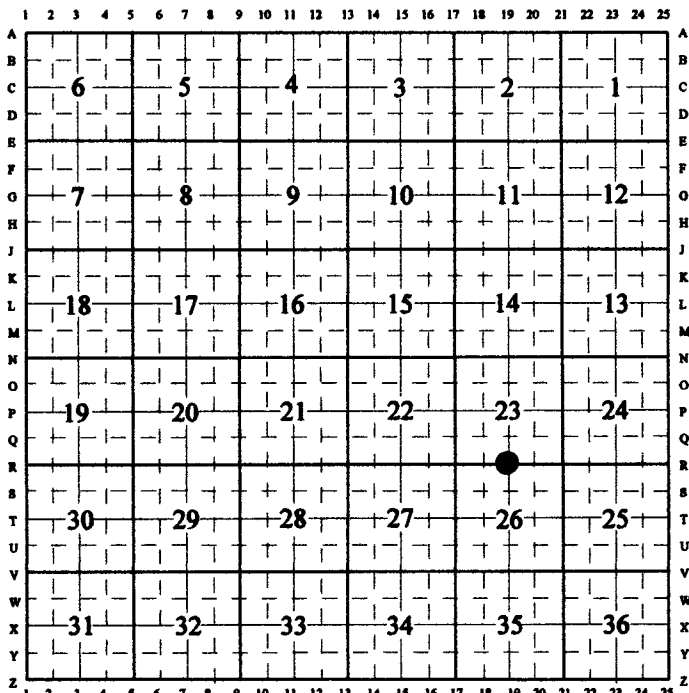
