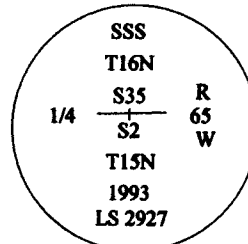
40.00 Chains Set a lime stone, 16 x 12 x 5 for 1/4 Section Corner

Subsequent Record: None

Found: 2" diam. alum. cap in a small collar of stones, marked as noted below and in an abandoned E/W fenceline. I set this corner in 1993 while employed by Steil Surveying Services. I searched the records of Steil Surveying Services and could not find my notes as to the evidence recovered in 1993 and the setting of the monument. I recall that this corner was set from evidence recovered from a retracement survey along the south township line for 3 1/2 miles.

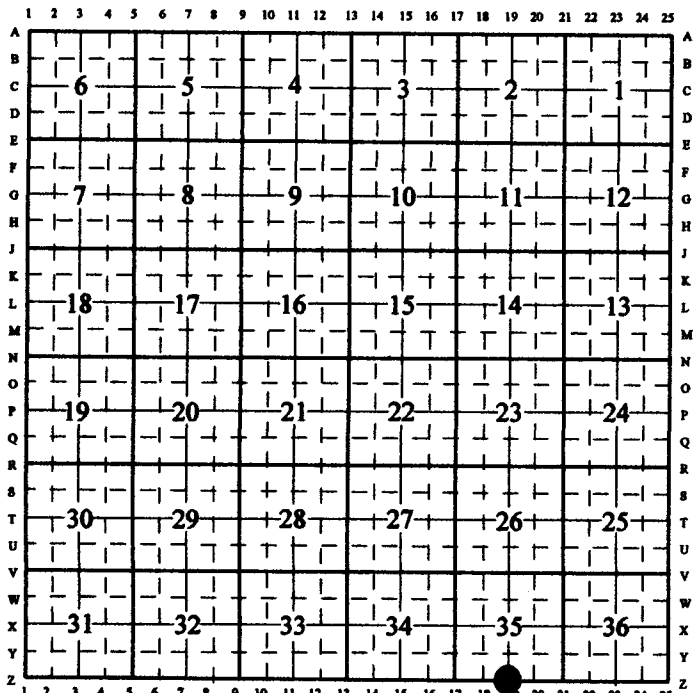
