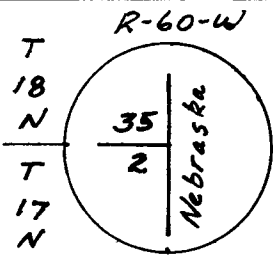

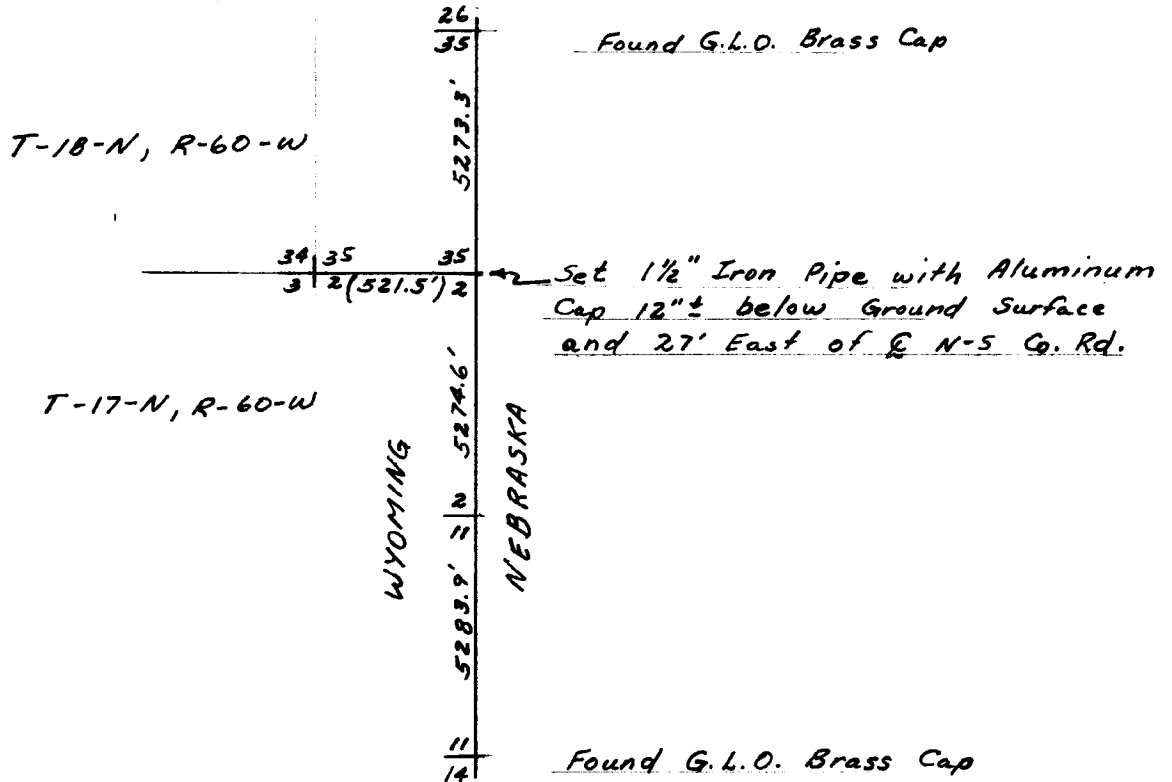
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (If known)

*No evidence of G.L.O. Brass Cap described as a 2 3/4" iron post 36" in length set 26" in ground.*

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

*Set a 1 1/2" Iron Pipe with Aluminum Cap 12" ± below ground surface. Single Proportional Method Used. Location is in east borrow pit of North-South County Road. G.L.O. Brass Cap Monument probably was lost during Road Construction.*
