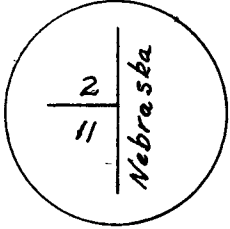

No evidence of G.L.O. Monument described as 36" x 2 3/4" Iron Post Set 26" in ground with Brass Cap attached.

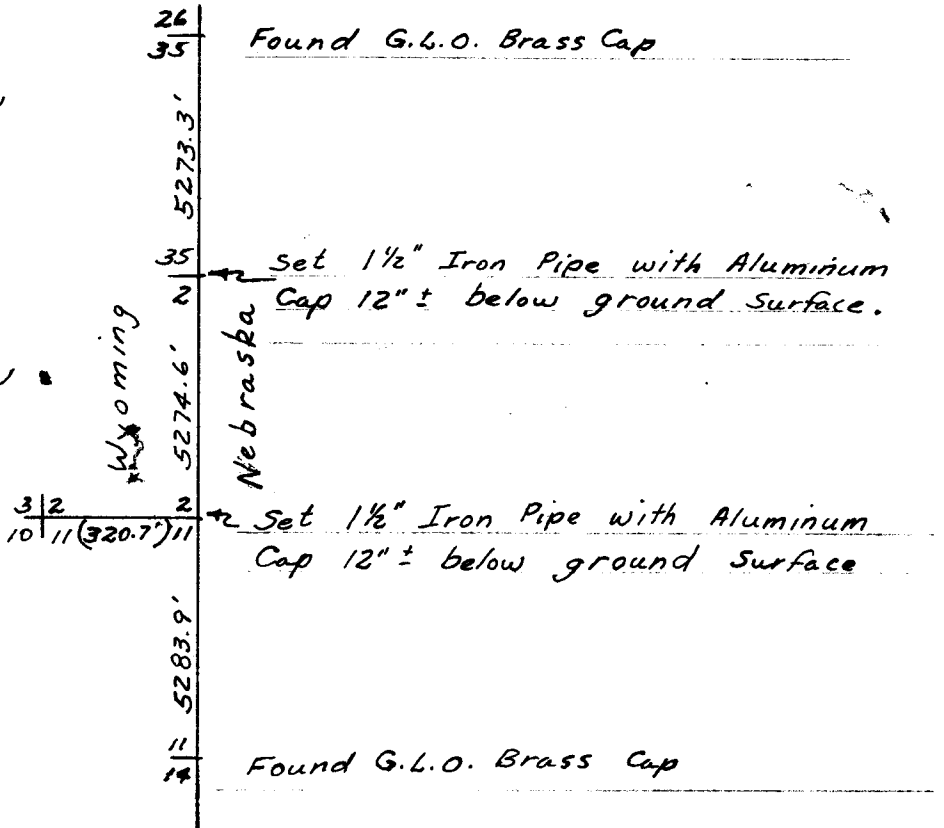
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Set a 1 1/2" Iron Pipe with Aluminum Cap 12" ± below ground surface. Single Proportional Method Used. Location is at the east edge of the east borrow pit of North-South County Road. G.L.O. Brass Cap probably was lost to Road Construction or farming which borders the road.
