G.L.O. record - sandstone 18" x 10" x 8".

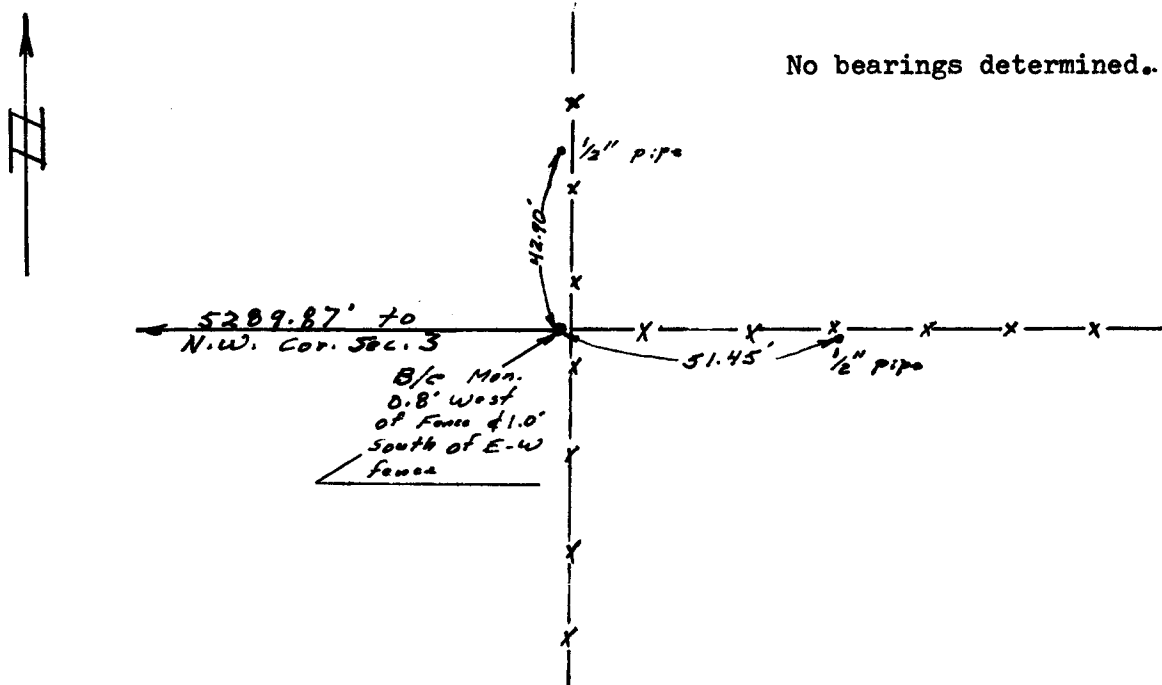
